

DEFLUX PROCEDURE
PRE-OP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Laboratory work (including urinalysis AND urine culture) **MUST** be done 10 days prior to surgery. We ask that you come to our office to pick up the necessary supplies and laboratory order sheet. If you fail to do this, surgery will be canceled.

*Please call the office for urine testing results two (2) days after testing.

IMPORTANT: If your child has a urinary infection, surgery will be canceled

2. There is no need for you to return to the office after the procedure unless there are any questions and/or problems.
3. After your child's procedure, we will schedule two follow-up tests:
 - a. A renal ultrasound will be obtained four weeks from the time of the procedure.
 - b. A nuclear VCUG will be obtained three months from the time of the procedure.

We ask that you return to the office after each test in order for the doctor to review the films and assess your child's progress.

Reminder - you will need to bring the films with you at the time of each office visit or we may need to reschedule your appointment.

IMPORTANT – YOUR CHILD WILL REMAIN ON THE PROPHYLACTIC ANTIBIOTIC UNTIL THE DOCTOR ADVISES DISCONTINUATION.
